4. What were the two major reasons you left the industry?
5. While you were performing, had you heard about others helping dancers/performers come out?

6. If someone came to you during your shift at the club with a gift how would you have accepted this?

7. Did you use drugs in any form during the years you were a dancer/performer?

If so where the drugs used while at the clubs/studios?

If so, where did you obtain the drugs?

8. Did you use alcohol before performing?

If so how often, and did it become addicting?

9. Did you see any drugs being sold or exchanged in the clubs you danced or performed in?

If so did the manager/owners know about it?

10. Did you participate in any form of sex for money?

If so, did the manager/owner know about it?

If so, did it happen on the property of the club/studio?

11. Did you see gambling in the clubs?
12. Were you employed by the club/studio or did you work as a contract laborer?
13. How much money did you make a day?
14. How many days did you normally work a week?
15. Did you pay other employees of the establishment to work there ie: bouncer, DJ etc.?
16. Did you pay income tax on the money you made?
17. What were you required to do buy the manager/owner to perform (tan, manicures, costumes)?

How much money did you spend on these items?

18. Who was your typical customer?
19. Were you offered gifts by the customers (drinks, jewelry, trips etc.)
20. Were you ever struck, pinched hit by the customers or managers/owners?

21. Did you perform VIP or “lap dances at the clubs”?

22. Did you ever go completely nude on or off the stage?

23. Did you ever see elected officials in your establishments?

If so, were they treated differently?

24. Were police officers or undercover police ever present in your establishment?

26. To the best of your knowledge how often were their health inspections at the clubs?

27. Did you ever see anyone that you knew was less than 18 years of age inside the clubs (including children)?

28. Did you ever have anything stolen from you at the clubs?
29. What was your relationship with the other dancers?
30. Did any of the dancers practice lesbianism to your knowledge?
31. Did you ever spend time with or get involved sexually with any of the patrons to the club? If so, what was the motivating factor in that choice? (money, safety, to feel loved and valued)
32. Did dancing negatively affect how you felt about yourself and your sexuality?
33. While you were dancing were you involved in a relationship that was emotionally, physically, or sexually abusive?
34. Were you ever forced to remain in the industry by someone because of the amount of money you made?
35. What kind of a childhood did you have?
36. Were you sexually abused as a child or teen?
37. If so, was your abuser someone you knew?
38. Would you be willing to participate in a dramatic concert of dance using your skills in a positive artistic manner to glorify God?

39. Are you willing to speak publicly about your life in the adult industry?

If so, are you willing to travel away from home, if expenses were paid?
