WHAT DO WE BELIEVE?

*Remember, it's not about religion, it's about relationship!
Below you will find details about the specifics of our Christian faith.
If anything is unclear to you, please ask and we will do our best to explain it further.*

- ◆ We believe that the Holy Bible, consisting of the sixty-six books of the Old and New Testaments, is the divinely inspired and infallible Word of God, the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of man, and the Divine and final authority for Christian faith and life. (II Timothy 3:15-16)
- ◆ We believe in the one, true, living God, eternally existing in three distinct persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4, Matthew 28:19, Mark 12:29)
- ◆ We believe that God is the creator and sustainer of all creation. (Genesis 2:3-4 & 7, John 1:2-4)
- ◆ We believe that Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary (Isaiah 7:14).
- ◆ We believe in salvation through the blood of Jesus. That He was crucified on the cross and His blood was shed for the sins of all mankind to fulfill the requirement of God and of the Law. (I John 5:10, Romans 10:13-15)
- ◆ We believe that Jesus Christ died, was bodily raised from the dead, ascended into heaven and will return to earth imminently and bodily, to judge the living and the dead. (Acts 24:15, Luke 14:14, Revelation 19:7-9)
- ◆ We believe that Jesus Christ is the only mediator between God and man. (I Timothy 2:5, Romans 8:34)
- ◆ We believe in the Holy Spirit, who is one of substance, equal in power, and coexistent with the Father and the Son. That His ministry is to convict men of their sins, and through His sanctifying power, allow us to live a Holy life by guiding, teaching, disciplining, comforting and empowering us for godly living and service. (Ezekiel 36:26-27)
- ◆ We believe in the gifts of the Holy Spirit mentioned in the Scriptures and that they are valid for today when exercised within the scriptural guidelines set forth in the Bible. (I Corinthians 12 thru I Corinthians 14)
- ◆ We believe in a public profession of faith. (Psalm 32:5, Romans 10:9-10, Philippians 2:11)
- ◆ We believe in water baptism by immersion. (Matthew 28:19)
- ◆ We believe in divine healing through the redemptive work of Jesus Christ on the cross. (Isaiah 53:4, Matthew 8:16, James 5: 13-14)
- ◆ We believe that hell is a real physical place of torment and eternal punishment reserved for those who refuse to yield their life, through Jesus Christ according to the calling of God the Father. (Revelation 20:12-15, John 5:28-29)
- ◆ We believe likewise that there will be a bodily resurrection of the just to eternal life. (I Thessalonians 4:16, John 6:39-40)
- ◆ We believe that we are saved by grace alone and not by works. (Eph 2:8-9)

COMMITMENT

Since I have committed myself to a new life with Jesus Christ, I have chosen that with God's help and through the guiding presence of His Holy Spirit, I will challenge myself to attain to the following guidelines for my life:

- ◆ I will constantly strive to place the desires of the Lord before my own.
(Matt 6:33, Matt 10:39, Psl 37:4)
- ◆ I will be truthful and honest in all of my associations with others.
(Prov 12:19, Col 3:9-10, Lev 19:11)
- ◆ I will refrain from all forms of gossip and malicious behavior.
(Matt 12:36-37, Rom 12:21, I Pet 3:8-9)
- ◆ I will encourage and admonish each person with love and mercy.
(Col 3:16, I John 3:18)
- ◆ I will not hold grievances against anyone, but always strive to immediately reconcile the situation, seeking mediation if necessary. (Matt 5:22-25, Col 3:12-13)
- ◆ I will abstain from the appearance of sexual immorality.
(Rom 6:11-12, I Cor 6:18-20, Titus 2:11-12)
- ◆ I will seek to establish new relationships with those that will encourage and support my new walk with Christ. (I Cor 15:33, II Cor 5:17)
- ◆ If single, I will abstain from intimate sexual relationships and dedicate the first 12 months of my new Christian walk to developing my relationship with the Lord.
(Ex 20:14, I Cor 6:18-20, I Cor 10:13, II Tim 2:22)
- ◆ If married, I will be faithful to my spouse and dedicate myself to putting into practice what I learn about my position in marriage from a Biblical perspective.
(Ex 20:14, Col 3:18-21, Eph 5:28, I Pet 3:7)
- ◆ If experiencing a divorce or separation from my spouse, I will abstain from intimate sexual relationships with anyone other than my spouse and dedicate myself to developing my personal relationship with the Lord.
(Ex 20:14, Mark 10:9, Matt 19:3-10)
- ◆ I will seek to know God better through His Word (Acts 20:32) and by spending time with Him in prayer daily. (Jer 33:3)
- ◆ To constantly gain a better understanding of my new life as a Christian, I will actively participate in classes and workshops that will expand my growth of discovering my new self worth in Christ. (Heb 11:6, Amos 5:6, I Chr 28:9)
- ◆ I will assemble faithfully for regular meetings of fellowship, learning and accountability. (II Thess 1:3, Isaiah 28:26)

- ◆ I will attend a minimum of one church service a week.
(I Pet 2:2, Acts 2:42, Acts 2:47)
- ◆ I will relinquish all objects reflective of occultism, witchcraft and idol worship and refrain from such practices, as “it is an abomination to the Lord.”
(Deut 18:10-13, Acts 19:19)
- ◆ I will share in the joys and bear the sorrows of those who I am surrounded by.
(Psl 126:5-6, Psl 30:5)
- ◆ I will pray earnestly for each person who God has brought into my life.
(I Tim 2:1, James 5:16)
- ◆ I will endeavor to bring up those in my care, “in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.” This includes children, ailing parents or grandparents, and any other who God has entrusted to me. (I Tim 5:8, I Tim 6:20)
- ◆ I will be a faithful steward of my God given resources and abilities.
(Deut 8:18, Mal 3:10)
- ◆ I will prove the reality of my conversion by living a Godly, fruitful life.
(Matt 5:16, Gal 5:22, Rom 12:2, John 15:8)
- ◆ I will seek, by Christian example and personal effort, to win others to Christ.
(Matt 16:15, II Tim 2:24-26)
- ◆ I will continually review the condition of my heart so as not to create or foster a stumbling block for others. (Ezek 3:20, Rom 14:13, I John 2:10)

Signing this is more an understanding between you and God than it is between you and LIGHTDANCERS. It is yours to keep as a personal reminder of your dedication and heartfelt promise to Him and to help establish a level of personal accountability in your new walk with the Lord Jesus Christ.
